Here are a few details to help you make up your mind:

- Burnham Beeches is a 374.6 hectare biological Site of Special Scientific Interest west of Farnham Common in Buckinghamshire. The walk will be about a couple of hours long.
- Meet at Burnham Beeches Car Park a few minutes before 10am. SL2 3PS will get you to the end of Beeches Road. From there, drive straight into BB and follow the road down to the café. From memory, this is a fair distance.
- Although dogs are normally allowed in Burnham Beeches, our guide has requested that dogs are not brought on this particular walk.
- Wear suitable clothing, i.e. stout walking shoes / boots and bring wet weather gear if it is likely to rain. Your comfort and safety is your responsibility.
- This walk is being organised for your pleasure but also to raise some money for the Friends of St Michael's. **The charge is: £8.00 per head.** A percentage of any money raised will be donated to Burnham Beeches. The rest will go to the Friends.

The objectives of the Friends are to raise funds for the preservation, repair, restoration and improvement of St. Michael's Church, Bray including the Church Hall and Churchyard.
