Dear Friends,

The church's electrical wiring is now of an age where complete replacement is urgently required, and this gives the opportunity to improve the lighting throughout the building.

The Church Council has looked at a number of options, and has selected a system which will mean everyone will be able to enjoy a greatly enhanced, modern, flexible and much more efficient system of lighting.

The total cost is expected to be around £100,000, we currently need to raise £30,000 to reach that total.

We are hopeful that we will be able to reclaim VAT through the government's Listed Places of Worship Scheme, but we are asking for your help, please, in raising enough to complete this vitally important project.

Gift Aid will be available if you are a taxpayer. All donations will be gratefully received.

On the 12th July at 7.00 pm in church, we will have a fundraising event for the Lighting Appeal. Mr Mike Parkinson Jnr will be talking about his father's life, with live music featuring Sir Michael's favourite pieces.

Alexander Devine Children's Hospice Service is a local charity that provides specialist care and vital support to babies, children and young people with life-limiting and life-threatening conditions, and their families, across Berkshire and into surrounding counties.

The charity was founded by Fiona and John Devine in memory of their son Alexander who sadly passed away from a rare brain tumour in 2006. Their personal experience led them to realise a desperate need for a local children's service with a hospice facility in Berkshire.

The Hospice currently supports over 200 children, and their families, and is committed to growing the service and reaching out to every child, and their family, that need their help.

The Hospice approach is child and family-centred in order to provide the best possible care and support that each family needs, as well as helping create memories for however long they have together.

The cost of running this service this financial year is £3 million. With minimal government funding, the Hospice is almost entirely reliant on the generosity of the community including donations, corporate and community support, Trusts, volunteering, fundraising and gifts in Wills.
